Pursuant to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Auckland) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 6.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Trout-fishing (Auckland) Regulations 1937* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the 6th day of October, 1943.
- 4. The Second Schedule to the Trout-fishing (Auckland) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 5, is hereby substituted for the Second Schedule (heretofore revoked) to the principal regulations.
- 5. The said Second Schedule so substituted by the last preceding regulation is hereby amended as follows:—
 - (a) By inserting, after the word "Mangatawhiri", the words "Mangatutu from its source to Lethbridge's Bridge":
 - (b) By inserting, after the word "Mangatutu", the words "below Lethbridge's Bridge to its mouth".
