PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Westland) Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 1.
2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Trout-fishing (Westland) Regulations 1938* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
3. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the words "1st day of October" and the words "the 30th day of April", and substituting the words "the 1st day of September" and the words "the 31st day of March" respectively.
