THE TROUT-FISHING (WESTLAND) REGULATIONS 1938, AMENDMENT NO. 2

Pursuant to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Westland) Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 2.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Trout-fishing (Westland) Regulations 1938* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations.)
- 3. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations, as amended by Regulation 3 of the Trout Fishing (Westland) Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 1†, is revoked, and the following regulation substituted:—
- "4. Whole-season licenses to fish for trout and other acclimatized fish issued by the Westland Acclimatization Society or any other acclimatization society under the general regulations shall entitle the holder to fish for trout and other acclimatized fish in the Westland Acclimatization District (hereinafter called the district) from the 1st day of October in any year to the 30th day of April in the year next following, both days inclusive."
- 4. The Trout-fishing (Westland) Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 1†, are revoked.
