THE TERMITES REGULATIONS 1940, AMENDMENT NO. 2

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Termites Act, 1940, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Termites Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Termites Regulations 1940* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended as follows:—
 - (a) By omitting from paragraph (d) of subclause (3) the words "Department of Scientific and Industrial Research, Auckland", and substituting the words "Director of the Entomological Department of the Cawthron Institute, Nelson":
 - (b) By omitting from paragraph (e) of the same subclause the words "the Department of Scientific and Industrial Research", and substituting the words "the said Director".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

Hitherto a local authority which in the course of an inspection of premises discovered evidence of the existence of termites has been required by regulation to send samples of the insects to the Department of Scientific and Industrial Research at Auckland. It has been found more convenient, however, to have these samples sent to the Director of the Entomological Department of the Cawthron Institute, Nelson. These regulations merely effectuate that change.
