THE TROUT-FISHING (ASHBURTON) REGULATIONS 1941, AMENDMENT NO. 1

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Ashburton) Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 1.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Trout-fishing (Ashburton) Regulations 1941* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the 6th day of October, 1943.
- **4.** Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is revoked and the following regulation substituted:—
- "6. Whole-season licenses to fish for trout and other acclimatized fish issued by the Ashburton Acclimatization Society or any other acclimatization society under the general regulations shall entitle the holder to fish in the district as under:—
 - "(a) For trout and other acclimatized fish, except salmon,—
 - "(i) In any waters other than the waters mentioned in clause (b) hereof, from the 1st day of October in any year to the 30th day of April in the year next following (both days inclusive):
 - "(ii) In all the lakes except the Maori lakes, from the 20th day of October in any year to the 30th day of April in the year next following (both days inclusive).

- "(b) For salmon, from the 1st day of October in any year to the 15th day of May in the year next following (both days inclusive), except in the case of persons licensed to take salmon for sale."
- 5. Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking paragraph (e) thereof.
- 6. It is hereby declared that these regulations, in so far as they affect the date of commencement and duration of the close season for trout, are made pursuant to section 93 of the Fisheries Act, 1908, and on the written application in that behalf of the Ashburton Acclimatization Society.
