THE TROUT-FISHING (WELLINGTON) REGULATIONS 1941, AMENDMENT NO. 1

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 20th day of September, 1944

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Wellington) Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 1.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Trout-fishing (Wellington) Regulations 1941* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1944.

4. Clause (b) of Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is amended as follows :—

(1) By inserting, after items (4) and (11) respectively thereof, the following additional items :—

"(4A) The Korarau Dam :

"(11A) The Porirua River below the Railway Bridge : "

(2) By revoking, in item 13 thereof, the words "below the Te Ore Ore Road Bridge".

5. Clause (a) of Regulation 9 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, at the commencement thereof, the words "Except as hereinafter provided".

6. Clause (b) of Regulation 9 of the principal regulations is amended as follows :—

(1) By inserting, after items (4), (12), (15), and (18) respectively thereof, the following additional items :—

"(4A) The Kaiwarra Stream :

"(12A) The Makara River:

"(15A) The Mangatainoka River:

"(18A) The Ohariu River : "

- (2) By revoking item (8):
- (3) By revoking item (34) and the proviso thereto, and substituting the following item :----
 - "(34) The tributaries of all rivers in the said district, except such tributary rivers and portions of tributary rivers as are named in clause (b) of Regulation 6 hereof."

7. The principal regulations are amended by inserting, next following Regulation 9 thereof, the following regulation :---

"9A. Notwithstanding Regulation 9 hereof, it shall be lawful to fish for trout, perch, tench, or other acclimatized fish with artificial fly or artificial minnow in the Kawatu and Moawhango Rivers."
