THE TOHEROA REGULATIONS 1946, AMENDMENT NO. 1

ORDER IN COUNCIL

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Toheroa Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 1.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Toheroa Regulations 1946* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the seventh day after notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.

4. The principal regulations are amended by inserting, next after Regulation 8, the following regulation :—

“ 8A. No person shall in any part of the Provincial District of Auckland in any one day (computed from midnight to midnight) and in any one vehicle convey more toheroa (not being canned toheroa), than is the limit number as set out in Regulations 8, 11, and 12 for the number of occupants of that vehicle.”
