THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Toheroa Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Toheroa Regulations 1946\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. (1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 11A (as enacted by regulation 5 of the Toheroa Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 3), and substituting the following regulation:

“ 11A. Notwithstanding anything in regulation 11 of these regulations, no person shall take or injure or disturb toheroa on any of the beaches on the west coast of the North Island between the Waikanae River and the Wanganui River during the period from the commencement of this regulation until and including the 31st day of December 1955.”

(2) Regulation 5 of the Toheroa Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 3, is hereby revoked.
