Pursuant to the Forests Act, 1921–22, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Timber Regulations 1948, Amendment No. 1.
- 2. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the Gazette of the making thereof.
- 3. Regulation 4 of the Timber Regulations 1948\* is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (3) the words "kahikatea or white pine (*Podocarpus dacrydioides*) timber for any purpose other than the manufacture of tallow-casks or butter-boxes or use as ships' dunnage, or of any".
