THE RIGHT HON. W. NASH PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Forests Act, 1921-22, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Timber Regulations 1948, Amendment No. 1.

2. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.

3. Regulation 4 of the Timber Regulations 1948* is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (3) the words "kahikatea or white pine (*Podocarpus dacrydioides*) timber for any purpose other than the manufacture of tallow-casks or butter-boxes or use as ships' dunnage, or of any".
