# ORDER IN COUNCIL

## HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Forests Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Timber Regulations 1948, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Timber Regulations 1948\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.

2. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the definition of the term "building timber", and substituting the following definition :---

"' Building timber' means timber that is manufactured into sizes, shapes, and qualities required for light building construction and general purpose uses : ".

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

These regulations amend the definition of the term "building timber" for the purposes of the Timber Regulations 1948 so as to make it clear that the term covers all timber that is manufactured into sizes, shapes, and qualities required for light building construction and general purpose uses, whether or not the timber has been classified in accordance with the regulations.
