PURSUANT to the Forests Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Timber Regulations 1948, Amendment No. 4.
- 2. These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
- 3. Regulation 4 of the Timber Regulations 1948* is hereby amended by revoking subclause (4).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These regulations amend the Timber Regulations 1948 so as to provide for the de-control of tawa.
