### THE TRANSPORT (ALLOWANCES) REGULATIONS 1949, AMENDMENT NO. 2

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 18th day of July, 1951

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Transport Act, 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Transport (Allowances) Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Transport (Allowances) Regulations 1949\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. (1) Regulation 4 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Transport (Allowances) Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 1) is hereby revoked, and the following regulation substituted:—
- "4. There shall be paid to each Licensing Authority or member of a Licensing Authority who is not an officer in the service of the Government and who is not the Licensing Authority or a member of a Licensing Authority exclusively for a harbour ferry service district an allowance by way of remuneration during his term of office at the rates following, namely:—

"(a) To each Licensing Authority or member of a Licensing Authority for the No. 1, No. 4, No. 6, No. 8, or No. 11 Transport District, £150 per annum:

"(b) To each Licensing Authority or member of a Licensing Authority for the No. 3 or No. 5 Transport District, £200 per annum:

- "(c) To each Licensing Authority or member of a Licensing Authority for the No. 2, No. 7, No. 9, or No. 10 Transport District, £250 per annum."
- (2) The Transport (Allowances) Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 1, are hereby revoked.
