**THE TRANSPORT (ALLOWANCES) REGULATIONS 1949,
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Transport Act, 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Transport (Allowances) Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Transport (Allowances) Regulations 1949* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) Regulation 4 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Transport (Allowances) Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 1) is hereby revoked, and the following regulation substituted:—

“ 4. There shall be paid to each Licensing Authority or member of a Licensing Authority who is not an officer in the service of the Government and who is not the Licensing Authority or a member of a Licensing Authority exclusively for a harbour ferry service district an allowance by way of remuneration during his term of office at the rates following, namely:—

“ (a) To each Licensing Authority or member of a Licensing Authority for the No. 1, No. 4, No. 6, No. 8, or No. 11 Transport District, £150 per annum :

“ (b) To each Licensing Authority or member of a Licensing Authority for the No. 3 or No. 5 Transport District, £200 per annum :

“ (c) To each Licensing Authority or member of a Licensing Authority for the No. 2, No. 7, No. 9, or No. 10 Transport District, £250 per annum.”

(2) The Transport (Allowances) Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 1, are hereby revoked.
