

THE TREASURY REGULATIONS 1953, AMENDMENT NO. 2

COBHAM, Governor-General ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 11th day of July 1962

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Public Revenues Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Treasury Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Treasury Regulations 1953* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date

of their notification in the Gazette.

- 2. Regulation 22 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the word "Minister", and substituting the words "Permanent Head".
- 3. Regulation 26 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "Whenever any person", and substituting the words "Except where the Audit Office otherwise approves in respect of any class of allowance, whenever any person".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

Regulation 2 permits Permanent Heads to appoint approving officers for the expenditure of public money. The appointments were previously made by the Minister.

Regulation 3 empowers the Audit Office to dispense with certain notices in respect of allowances.
