ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 26th day of June 1972

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Toheroa Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 10, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Toheroa Regulations 1955* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Leases for canning purposes—(1) The principal regulations (as amended by regulation 11 of the Toheroa Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 2) are hereby further amended by revoking regulation 14, and substituting the following regulation:
- "14. The Minister may from time to time by public notice invite tenders for the lease of any area, and may prescribe rents, royalties, terms, and conditions of leases and terms and conditions of tendering."
- (2) Regulation 11 of the Toheroa Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 2, is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Toheroa Regulations 1955, by revoking regulation 14 (as substituted by regulation 11 of the Toheroa Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 2), and substituting a new regulation which reverts to the original form of regulation 14, as first enacted in 1955.
