

THE TOHEROA REGULATIONS 1955, AMENDMENT NO. 12

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Fisheries Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Toheroa Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 12, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Toheroa Regulations 1955* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Close season for taking toheroa—(1) Regulation 2 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 of the Toheroa Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 11) is hereby further amended by revoking the definition of the expression "close season", and substituting the following definition:
 - "'Close season' means the period commencing with the day on which the Toheroa Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 12, come into force and ending with the 30th day of November 1974:"
- (2) The Toheroa Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 11, is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These regulations provide for a new close season for toheroa from the day on which the regulations come into force and ending with 30 November 1974.
