THE TOHEROA REGULATIONS 1955, AMENDMENT NO. 15

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 30th day of August 1976

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Toheroa Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 15, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Toheroa Regulations 1955\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 17th day of September 1976.

**2. Open season for taking toheroa**—Notwithstanding anything in the definition of “close season” in regulation 2 (1) of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Toheroa Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 13), there shall be an open season for the taking of toheroa for the period commencing on the 17th day of September 1976 and ending with the 30th day of September 1976 on—

(a) Muriwai Beach:

(b) That part of Dargaville Beach lying between North Head and Maunganui Bluff.

**3. Revocation**—Regulation 2 of the Toheroa Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 14, is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations amend the Toheroa Regulations 1955. The effect is to allow toheroa to be taken from Muriwai Beach and from Dargaville Beach between North Head and Maunganui Bluff during the period 17 September 1976 to 30 September 1976 inclusive.
