

## THE TOHEROA REGULATIONS 1955. AMENDMENT NO. 19

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 1st day of September 1980

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Toheroa Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 19, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Toheroa Regulations 1955\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) Except as provided by regulation 2 (2) of these regulations, these regulations shall come into force on the 13th day of September 1980.
- 2. Interpretation—(1) Regulation 2 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from the definition of "close season" (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Toheroa Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 13 and amended by regulation 2 (2) of the Toheroa Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 16) the expressions "1977" and "1980", and substituting respectively the expressions "1980" and "1983".
- (2) This regulation shall come into force on the 1st day of December 1980.

3. Open season for taking toheroa—Notwithstanding the definition of the term "close season" in the said regulation 2 (1) (as so amended), there shall be an open season for the taking of toheroa—

(a) In the South Island, during the period commencing on the 13th day of September 1980 and expiring with the 19th day of

September 1980, on—

(i) Oreti Beach, excluding that portion of Oreti Beach lying between New River and a point 1 km south of the southern beach entrance:

(ii) Te Waewae Bay:

- (b) In the North Island, during the period commencing on the 20th day of September 1980 and expiring with the 26th day of September 1980, on that part of Dargaville Beach lying between North Head and Maunganui Bluff.
- 4. Revocations—The following regulations are hereby consequentially revoked:
- (a) Regulations 2 (2) and 2 (3) of the Toheroa Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 16:
- (b) Regulation 2 of the Toheroa Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 18.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general

These regulations provide for an open season for the taking of toheroa during the periods and from the beaches specified in regulation 3. They also extend the general close season for a further period of 3 years.
