THE TRAFFIC REGULATIONS 1956, AMENDMENT NO. 14

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 27th day of July 1966

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Traffic Regulations 1956, Amendment No. 14, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Traffic Regulations 1956* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. (1) Regulation 52 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (8) (as amended by regulation 2 of the Traffic Regulations 1956, Amendment No. 13), and substituting the following subclause:

“(8) For the first application for inspection by an officer of the Crown or on behalf of a Council for the issue of a warrant of fitness there shall be payable a fee of 5s. in the case of a warrant in respect of a motor cycle or trailer and a fee of 7s. in the case of a warrant in respect of any other kind of motor vehicle. No additional fee may be charged in either case for subsequent applications for the purposes of the same warrant, nor, if the warrant is issued within 28 days after the making of the first application for inspection, for the issue of the warrant.”

(2) The Traffic Regulations 1956, Amendment No. 13, is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations reduce the fee in respect of warrants of fitness issued by officials of the Crown for motor cycles and trailers from 7s. to 5s.
