

THE TRAFFIC REGULATIONS 1956, AMENDMENT NO. 6

COBHAM, Governor-General ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 24th day of January 1962

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Traffic Regulations 1956, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Traffic Regulations 1956* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Regulation 26 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (1) the words "fifty miles an hour", and substituting the words "fifty-five miles an hour".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These regulations increase the general speed limit from fifty to fifty-five miles an hour.
