THE TRAFFIC REGULATIONS 1956, AMENDMENT NO. 6

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 24th day of January 1962

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Traffic Regulations 1956, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Traffic Regulations 1956* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Regulation 26 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (1) the words "fifty miles an hour", and substituting the words "fifty-five miles an hour".
