## THE TELEPHONE REGULATIONS 1961, AMENDMENT NO. 1

PURSUANT to the Post Office Act 1959, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Telephone Regulations 1961, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Telephone Regulations 1961\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 147, the following regulation:

#### *“Credit Toll Cards*

“147A. (1) Credit toll cards may be issued to any subscriber on payment of the prescribed fee.

“(2) Use of credit toll cards shall be subject to such conditions as the Director-General may from time to time determine.

“(3) On payment of the prescribed additional fee a subscriber holding a credit toll card may have the charge for a toll call debited to a station nominated in that behalf by the subscriber on the issue of the credit toll card.”

3. Division 2 of Part 9 of the First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the following clause:

“(8) Credit toll card service (Reg. 147A)					s.	d.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations provide for a credit toll card service by the Post Office. The amendment permits the issue of credit toll cards which will enable the holder to use any telephone station for a toll call and debit the charge to a station nominated by him when the card is issued.
