THE TELEX REGULATIONS 1963, AMENDMENT NO. 2

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 28th day of March 1967

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. KEITH HOLYOAKE, C.H., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Post Office Act 1959, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Telex Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Telex Regulations 1963* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1967.

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 15, and substituting the following regulation:

“Annual Rental

“15. (1) Every subscriber to the telex service shall pay an annual rental of £200 for each telex installation leased by the subscriber.

“(2) For special services the subscriber shall pay the charge or charges prescribed hereunder:

Provided that, in the case of a tape reperforator, the installation charge shall not be payable if the service is provided at the same time as the subscriber's telex installation.”

3. Regulation 18 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (1) the words “3d.”, and substituting the words “4d.”.

4. Regulation 39 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (b) of subclause (2) the words "3d.", in each case where they occur, and substituting in each case the words "6d."

5. Regulation 40 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (a) of subclause (1) the words "10 0 0" and substituting the words "15 0 0".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase telex rentals and call charges; the fee for telegrams lodged by telex; and the charge for removal of a telex installation to other premises.
