## THE TRANSPORT (WAYBILL) REGULATIONS 1970

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 16th day of November  
1970

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Transport (Waybill) Regulations 1970.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of February 1971.

**2. Form of waybill**—(1) The waybill for the conveyance of goods to be carried on a heavy motor vehicle pursuant to section 109A of the Transport Act 1962 shall be in the form set out in the Schedule hereto.

(2) Notwithstanding anything in subclause (1) of this regulation or in the Schedule hereto,—

(a) Any consignment note specifying the matters included in the said form shall be a waybill for the purposes of section 109A of the Transport Act 1962:

(b) A stock consignment note in the form prescribed in the Conveyance of Stock Regulations 1958\* used pursuant to the Animals Act 1967 shall be a waybill for the purposes of section 109A of the Transport Act 1962.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

Section 109A of the Transport Act 1962 (as inserted by section 16 of the Transport Amendment Act (No. 2) 1969) provides that, unless the vehicle is exempted under that section, no person shall use on a road any heavy motor vehicle carrying goods of any description unless there is carried on the vehicle a waybill, which must be produced on demand by any traffic officer. The form of waybill is to be prescribed by regulations.

These regulations prescribe the form of waybill for the purposes of section 109A.
