PURSUANT to the Post Office Act 1959, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Telephone Regulations 1976, Amendment No. 13, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Telephone Regulations 1976* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of December 1983.

2. First Schedule—Part IX of the First Schedule to the principal Regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Telephone Regulations 1976, Amendment No. 8 and amended by regulation 4 of the Telephone Regulations 1976, Amendment No. 9) is hereby further amended by revoking clause 1, and substituting the new clause 1 set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

SCHEDULE

New clause 1 of Part IX of the First Schedule to the principal regulations.

“1. Basic rates for ordinary calls (Reg. 131)—

(a) Charging categories for toll calls shall be as follows:

	<i>Charging Category</i>
Monday to Saturday inclusive*	
Midnight to 6 a.m.	Off-peak rate
6 a.m. to 8 a.m.	Night rate
8 a.m. to 6 p.m.	Full rate
6 p.m. to 11 p.m.	Night rate
11 p.m. to midnight	Off-peak rate
Sundays & Public Holidays†	
Midnight to 6 a.m.	Off-peak rate
6 a.m. to 11 p.m.	Full rate
11 p.m. to midnight	Off-peak rate:

*‘Monday to Saturday’ means any day from Monday to Saturday inclusive, not being a Public Holiday or day substituted therefor.

†‘Public Holiday’ means New Year’s Day, and the 2nd day of January, Waitangi Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Anzac Day, the Sovereign’s Birthday, Labour Day, Christmas Day, and Boxing Day or any days substituted therefor.

(b) The following basic charges are payable in respect of toll calls:

(i) For distances up to and including 50 kilometres for each 3 minutes conversation or fraction thereof:

	<i>Full rate</i>	<i>Night rate</i>	<i>Off-peak rate</i>
Up to and including 40 km	14c	14c	7c
Over 40 km but not over 50 km	28c	28c	14c:

(ii) For distances over 50 km for the initial period of 3 minutes or fraction thereof:

Over 50 km but not over 65 km	45c	39c	21c
Over 65 km but not over 100 km	69c	54c	27c
Over 100 km but not over 165 km	\$1.05	72c	36c
Over 165 km but not over 245 km	\$1.38	96c	48c
Over 245 km but not over 325 km	\$1.74	\$1.17	60c
Over 325 km but not over 485 km	\$2.10	\$1.44	72c
Over 485 km but not over 650 km	\$2.58	\$1.86	93c
Over 650 km	\$2.85	\$2.04	\$1.02

For each minute or fraction of a minute exceeding the initial period of 3 minutes, one-third of the initial charge.

SCHEDULE—*continued*

For a call from a coin-box telephone, any part of 3 minutes shall be charged for as 3 minutes:

(iii) For an urgent call, double the charge for an ordinary call plus the prescribed charges for any special services:

(iv) For a local call from a toll station:

To a private-line owner connected with the station . . . 6c

To a subscriber's station of an exchange, the base rate area of which includes the site on which the toll station is situated 6c".

 EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations come into force on 1 December 1983 and provide for toll calls made at off-peak times to be charged at a reduced rate. Charges other than those for off-peak toll calls remain unchanged.
