THE TUNNELS REGULATIONS 1983, AMENDMENT NO. 1

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 29th day of June 1987

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Quarries and Tunnels Act 1982, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Tunnels Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Tunnels Regulations 1983* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Increasing fees—The principal regulations are hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from regulation 3 (2) the expression “\$10”, and substituting the expression “\$25”;
- (b) By omitting from regulation 3 (2) the expression “\$5” in both places where it occurs, and substituting in each case the expression “\$10”;
- (c) By omitting from regulation 4 (1) the expression “\$10”, and substituting the expression “\$25”;

- (d) By omitting from form 1 in the Schedule the expression "\$10", and substituting the expression "\$25":
- (e) By omitting from the said form 1 the expression "\$5", and substituting the expression "\$10":
- (f) By omitting from form 2 in the Schedule the expression "\$10", and substituting the expression "\$25".

3. Other amendments—The principal regulations are hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from regulation 3 (4) the words "Secretary of the Board, Mines Division of the", and substituting the words "Board of Examiners,":
- (b) By omitting from regulation 3 (9) the words "who is not otherwise employed in a department of State":
- (c) By omitting from regulation 109 (1) the words "Deputy Secretary", and substituting the words "Secretary of Energy".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

Regulation 2 of these regulations increases various application fees payable under the principal regulations.

Regulation 3 (a) omits a redundant reference to the Mines Division.

Regulation 3 (b) allows the payment of fees to examination supervisors notwithstanding that they are employed in a department of State.

Regulation 3 (c) changes a reference to the Deputy Secretary of Energy (Mines Division) to the Secretary of Energy.
