



THE TARIFF (FEES) REGULATIONS 1991

ORDER IN COUNCIL

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 16A of the Tariff Act 1988, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Tariff (Fees) Regulations 1991.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 7th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Fees for applications relating to certain tariff concessions—A fee of \$252 shall be payable for applications of the following kinds:

- (a) An application for any approval under section 8 (1) of the Tariff Act 1988 in respect of the entry of goods falling within the descriptions set out in concession reference numbers 25, 26, and 99 in Part II of the Tariff;
- (b) An application under section 8 (2) of that Act for the withdrawal or modification of any approval granted under section 8 (1) of that Act in respect of any such goods.

3. Goods and services tax—The fees prescribed by these regulations are inclusive of any amount of goods and services tax payable under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on the 7th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, set a fee of \$252 for applications for tariff concession approvals under section 8 of the Tariff Act 1988 in respect of—

- (a) Medicaments and pharmaceutical goods under concession reference numbers 25 and 26 in Part II of the Tariff; and
- (b) Goods that come under concession reference number 99 (which covers goods not otherwise specifically mentioned in Part II of the Tariff).

The same fee is also payable in respect of applications for the withdrawal or modification of an approval given in respect of any such goods.
