REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Transport (Vehicle Registration and Licensing) Amendment Regulations 1999, and are part of the Transport (Vehicle Registration and Licensing) Regulations 1994* ("the principal regulations").
 - (2) These regulations come into force on 3 May 1999.

Transport (Vehicle Registration and Licensing) Amendment Regulations 1999

- 2. Further exemptions—Regulation 3A of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the words "a vehicle inspection certificate issued under the Transport Act 1962", and substituting the words "evidence of vehicle inspection issued under the Land Transport Act 1998".
- **3. Amendments to First Schedule**—Part I of the First Schedule of the principal regulations is amended,—
 - (a) By inserting in paragraph 1, after the expression "Transport Act 1962", the words "or under regulations or rules made under the Land Transport Act 1998"; and
 - (b) By omitting from paragraph 3 the words "within the meaning of the Transport Act 1962".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 3 May 1999, update references in the principal regulations to take account of the enactment of the Land Transport Act 1998.
