

THE TRANSPORT (VEHICLE REGISTRATION AND LICENSING) REGULATIONS 1994, AMENDMENT NO. 1

ORDER IN COUNCIL

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 35A of the Transport (Vehicle and Driver Registration and Licensing) Act 1986, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—These regulations may be cited as the Transport (Vehicle Registration and Licensing) Regulations 1994, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Transport (Vehicle Registration and Licensing) Regulations 1994* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day of April 1995.
- 2. Further exemptions—The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 3, the following regulation:

"3A. Any motor vehicle that is being used on any road solely for the

purposes of obtaining—

"(a) The certificate referred to in section 7 (2A) of the Transport (Vehicle

and Driver Registration and Licensing) Act 1986; or "(b) The certificate referred to in section 10 (1A) of the Transport (Vehicle and Driver Registration and Licensing) Act 1986,is hereby exempted from the licensing requirements of section 5 of the Act."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 28 April 1995, amend the Transport (Vehicle Registration and Licensing) Regulations 1994 by creating a new exemption from the requirement to licence a motor vehicle before using the motor vehicle on the road. The new exemption enables a vehicle to be driven solely for the purpose of obtaining the vehicle identification certificate needed to licence a vehicle.
