



**THE TRANSPORT (CHILD RESTRAINTS AND SEAT BELTS
APPROVAL) NOTICE 1984, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

PURSUANT to section 77B of the Transport Act 1962, the Secretary for Transport hereby gives the following notice.

—

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Transport (Child Restraints and Seat Belts Approval) Notice 1984, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Transport (Child Restraints and Seat Belts Approval) Notice 1984* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Approved child restraints—The principal notice is hereby amended by revoking clause 2, and substituting the following clause:

“2. (1) The following child restraints are hereby approved for the purposes of regulations 30 and 30A of the Traffic Regulations 1976† in respect of all vehicles so long as the child restraints are fitted and used in accordance with the standard concerned:

“(a) Child restraints that comply with New Zealand Standard 5411 and are labelled or otherwise marked accordingly:

“(b) Butler Baby Safe Capsule child restraints that comply with Australian Standard 1754 and are labelled or otherwise marked accordingly:

“(c) General Motors Infant Loveseat child restraints that comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard 213 of the United States of America and are labelled or otherwise marked accordingly:

“(d) Child restraints that comply with Economic Commission for Europe regulation 44 and are labelled or otherwise marked accordingly.

“(2) Subject to subclause (3) of this clause, the following child restraints are hereby approved for the purposes of regulations 30 and 30A of the Traffic Regulations 1976† in respect of all vehicles so long as the child restraints are manufactured before the 1st day of December 1989 and are fitted and used in accordance with the standard concerned:

- “(a) Child restraints that comply with Australian Standard 1754 and are labelled or otherwise marked accordingly:
- “(b) Child restraints that comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard 213 of the United States of America and are labelled or otherwise marked accordingly:
- “(c) Child restraints that comply with British Standard 3254 and are labelled or otherwise marked accordingly:
- “(d) Child restraints that comply with Trafiksakerhetsverk Forfattnings Samling 1978:3 (Sweden) and are labelled or otherwise marked accordingly.
- “(3) The approval given by subclause (2) of this clause shall expire with the close of the 1st day of March 1992.”

3. Approved seat belts—(1) Clause 3 (1) of the principal notice is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (c), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(c) Seat belts that comply with Rule 4.00 or Rule 4C or Rule 4D of the Australian Design Rules and are labelled or otherwise marked accordingly:”.

(2) Clause 3 (1) of the principal notice is hereby further amended by adding the following paragraph:

“(h) Seat belts that comply with Japanese Industrial Standard D4604 and are labelled or otherwise marked accordingly.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice amends the list of child restraints and seat belts approved by the Transport (Child Restraints and Seat Belts Approval) Notice 1984 for the purposes of the Traffic Regulations 1976.

The principal changes are—

- (a) The approval of Butler Baby Safe Capsule child restraints that comply with Australian Standard 1754 and General Motors Infant Loveseat child restraints that comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard 213 of the United States of America:
- (b) The existing approved child restraints specified in new clause 2 (2) may be used until 1 March 1992:
- (c) Seat belts that comply with Rule 4.00 or Rule 4C or Rule 4D of the Australian Design Rules or Japanese Industrial Standard D4604 are approved.
