



**TRANSPORT (VEHICLE STANDARDS) AMENDMENT
REGULATIONS 1997**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 199 of the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Transport (Vehicle Standards) Amendment Regulations 1997, and are part of the Transport (Vehicle Standards) Regulations 1990* (“the principal regulations”).

(2) These regulations come into force on 4 August 1997.

2. Vehicle standards fee—(1) Regulation 38 of the principal regulations (as amended by section 35 (3) of the Land Transport Act 1993) is amended by omitting from subclause (1) the expression “\$10”, and substituting the expression “\$18”.

(2) Regulation 38 of the principal regulations (as so amended) is amended by adding the following subclause:

“(3) The fee prescribed by this regulation is inclusive of goods and services tax.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 4 August 1997, amend the Transport (Vehicle Standards) Regulations 1990 by increasing the prescribed vehicle standards fee from \$10 to \$18. A new subclause (3) is inserted into regulation 38 of the principal regulations which clarifies that the fee is GST inclusive.

The fee is payable on the first registration in New Zealand of a motor vehicle.
