REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Transport (Vehicle Standards) Amendment Regulations 1999, and are part of the Transport (Vehicle Standards) Regulations 1990* (“the principal regulations”).

(2) These regulations come into force on 1 March 1999.

2. Revocations—The principal regulations are amended by revoking—

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 March 1999, are made under the Land Transport Act 1998. They amend the Transport (Vehicle Standards) Regulations 1990 by revoking provisions replaced or made redundant by Land Transport Rule 35001—Vehicle Standards (Compliance), which also comes into force on 1 March 1999. Land Transport Rules are made under the Land Transport Act 1998.
