PURSUANT to the Trustee Savings Banks Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Trustee Savings Banks Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Trustee Savings Banks Regulations 1949* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 27 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 of the Trustee Savings Banks Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 4) is hereby further amended by revoking subclause (5).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These regulations revoke regulation 27 (5) of the principal regulations, which prohibits the Waikato Savings Bank from instituting cheque facilities for clubs and societies.
