- (1) This notice is the Transport (Breath Tests) Amendment Notice 2002.
- (2) In this notice, the Transport (Breath Tests) Notice (No 2) 1989¹ is called "the principal notice".

Commencement

This notice comes into force on 1 November 2002.

3 Interpretation

Clause 2(1) of the principal notice is amended by revoking the definition of **Seres**, and substituting the following definition: "**Seres** means a Seres Ethylometre model 679T or a Seres Ethylometre model 679ENZ; and includes any device having the trade name 'Seres' and associated with the number 679."

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which comes into force on 1 November 2002, amends the Transport (Breath Tests) Notice (No 2) 1989 ("the principal notice").

The definition of the term **Seres** in the principal notice is amended to include a device called the Seres Ethylometre model 679ENZ. Under the principal notice, the Seres is an evidential breath-testing device within the meaning of that term in section 2(1) of the Land Transport Act 1998.
