**THE TEACHERS TRAINING COLLEGE REGULATIONS 1959,
AMENDMENT NO. 5**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 2nd day of June 1965

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Teachers Training College Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Teachers Training College Regulations 1959* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) Regulation 5 of the principal regulations, as amended by subclause (1) of regulation 2 of the Teachers Training College Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 2, is hereby further amended by revoking subclause (1), and substituting the following subclause:

“(1) For the purpose of demonstrating good modern educational practice, there shall be affiliated with each teachers college (other than a post-primary teachers college) one or more normal schools. A normal school shall include—

“(a) A main school which may be a full primary school, a contributing school, or an intermediate school:

“(b) Model schools of such number and type as may be approved by the Director:

“Provided that, where the Minister in view of local circumstances so approves, a normal school may consist solely of a full primary school, a contributing school, or an intermediate school; and in any such case,

the Director shall select one or more public schools in reasonable proximity to the normal school to be attached to that school as model schools, and the teaching staff of those public schools shall then be deemed, in respect of matters relating to the training of students of the teachers college but no other matters, to form part of the staff of the normal school."

(2) Regulation 3 of the Teachers Training College Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 3, is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

Under the existing regulations, where a public school is attached to a normal school as a model school, the teaching staff of the public school is deemed to form part of the staff of the normal school. This amendment modifies this provision so as to provide that the teaching staff of the public school shall be deemed to form part of the normal school in respect of matters relating to the teaching of students of the teachers college but not in respect of other matters.
