**THE TECHNICAL TEACHERS CERTIFICATE REGULATIONS
1960, AMENDMENT NO. 3**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 19th day of December 1966

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Technical Teachers Certificate Regulations 1960, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Technical Teachers Certificate Regulations 1960* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (b) of Section II (which paragraph sets out certain provisions to apply in respect of the subjects for Section II of the Technical Teachers Certificate Examination), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(b) No candidate will be accepted for any subject of this Section until he has completed English and at least two other subjects of Section I, and no candidate shall be accepted for Technical Drawing for this Section unless he has completed that subject for Section I.”.

3. (1) Regulation 8 of the principal regulations, as amended by regulation 2 of the Technical Teachers Certificate Regulations 1960, Amendment No. 1, is hereby further amended by revoking paragraph (b) of Section III (which paragraph sets out certain provisions to apply in respect of the subjects for Section III of the Technical Teachers Certificate Examination), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(b) Candidates may take subjects (1) and (2) at any time after completing three subjects of Section I, but no candidate will be accepted for subjects (3), (4), and (5) of this Section until he has completed three subjects of Section II.”.

(2) The Technical Teachers Certificate Regulations 1960, Amendment No. 1, are hereby consequentially revoked.

4. (1) The portion of regulation 10 of the principal regulations which relates to the scope of the examination in the several subjects of Section III for the Technical Teachers Certificate is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (d) of the portion of subclause (5) under the heading "(A) Special Study", and substituting the following paragraph:

"(d) The study, which must be original, shall be forwarded in type-script to the Director-General of Education, Wellington, but the Director-General shall not credit the candidate with a pass in that subject at any time before the candidate has completed the other Section III subjects."

(2) The portion of regulation 10 of the principal regulations which relates to the scope of the examination in the several subjects of Section III for the Technical Teachers Certificate is hereby further amended by revoking paragraph (d) of the portion of subclause (5) under the heading "(B) Project Design", and substituting the following paragraph:

"(d) The design, which must be original, shall be forwarded to the Director-General of Education, Wellington, but the Director-General shall not credit the candidate with a pass in that subject at any time before the candidate has completed the other Section III subjects."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations provide for a variation in certain conditions relating to the attainment of a pass in the Technical Teachers Certificate Examinations.
