# THE TAUPO TROUT FISHING REGULATIONS 1950, AMENDMENT NO. 7

# ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 16th day of October 1956

#### Present:

THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act 1908 and section 14 of the Maori Land Claims and Maori Land Adjustment Act 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Taupo Trout Fishing Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 7, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Taupo Trout Fishing Regulations 1950\* (here-inafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. (1) Regulation 9 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (1), and substituting the following subclause:

"(1) All licences shall be issued under the hand of an issuing officer, and, in the case of a monthly or weekly licence or a licence for more days than one, shall be generally in form 1 in the Second Schedule hereto, and, in the case of a day licence, shall be generally in form 2 in that Schedule."

(2) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule, and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

- (3) The following regulations are hereby revoked, namely:
- (a) Subclause (2) of regulation 2 of the Taupo Trout Fishing Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 1:
- (b) Regulation 3 of the Taupo Trout Fishing Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 4.

3. Regulation 18 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 6 of the Taupo Trout Fishing Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 6) is hereby amended as follows:

- (a) By inserting, before the words "The holder of", the words "Subject to the provisions of subclause (2) of regulation 44 hereof":
- (b) By inserting, after the words "except in", the words "the waters specified in subclause (1) of regulation 44 hereof or in".

4. Regulation 34 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting in paragraph (e), after the words "one hook", the words "or any multiple hook".

5. (1) Subclause (1) of regulation 44 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (d), as added by regulation 3 of the Taupo Trout Fishing Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 2.

(2) The Taupo Trout Fishing Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 2, are hereby revoked.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

Regulation 2 substitutes new forms of licences to fish in the Taupo Trout Fishing District, one form being for monthly and weekly licences and licences for several days and the other for one day licences.

Regulation 3 amends the description of the waters in which licences are available, and excludes the waters described in regulation 44 of the principal regulations where fishing is either prohibited at all times or prohibited during certain months of the year.

The effect of regulation 4 is to prohibit the use of a multiple hook with any form of spoon bait.

Regulation 5 amends the description of the waters in which fishing is prohibited at all times.
