HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act 1908 and section 14 of the Maori Land Amendment and Maori Land Claims Adjustment Act 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Taupo Trout Fishing (Special Season) Regulations 1954, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Taupo Trout Fishing (Special Season) Regulations 1954* (hereinafter referred to as the special regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, and shall expire on the 31st day of October 1954.

2. Regulation 12 of the special regulations is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:

"(m) That portion of the Wanganui River which is within the Taupo Trout Fishing District."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

The effect of these regulations is to prohibit the fishing for trout during the special experimental season in that part of the Wanganui River which is within the Taupo Trout Fishing District.
