



**THE TRANSPORT (BREATH TESTS) NOTICE (NO. 2) 1989,
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

PURSUANT to section 57A of the Transport Act 1962, the Minister of Transport hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Transport (Breath Tests) Notice (No. 2) 1989, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Transport (Breath Tests) Notice (No. 2) 1989* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1993.

2. Interpretation—Clause 2(1) of the principal notice is hereby amended by inserting, after the definition of the term “Alcosensor II”, the following definition:

“ ‘Alcotech AR 1005’ means an Alcotech AR 1005 handheld breath analyser; and includes any device having the trade name ‘Alcotech’ and associated with the expression ‘AR 1005’.”

3. Approval of passive breath-testing device—The principal notice is hereby amended by inserting, after clause 2, the following clause:

“2A. The Alcotech AR 1005 is hereby approved as a kind of passive breath-testing device.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which comes into force on 1 April 1993, amends the Transport (Breath Tests) Notice (No. 2) 1989 by approving the Alcotest AR 1005 as a kind of passive breath-testing device.
