



**THE TRANSPORT (BREATH TESTS) NOTICE (NO. 2) 1989,  
AMENDMENT NO. 4**

PURSUANT to section 57A of the Transport Act 1962, the Minister of Transport hereby gives the following notice.

—

NOTICE

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This notice may be cited as the Transport (Breath Tests) Notice (No. 2) 1989, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Transport (Breath Tests) Notice (No. 2) 1989\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Interpretation**—Clause 2(1) of the principal notice is hereby amended—

- (a) By revoking the definition of the term “DataMaster”;
- (b) By omitting from the definition of the term “Seres” the expression “S 679”, and substituting the expression “679T”.

**3. Approval of evidential breath-testing devices**—The principal notice is hereby amended by revoking clause 7, and substituting the following clause:

“7. The following devices are hereby approved as kinds of evidential breath-testing devices for the purposes of evidential breath tests:

- “(a) Alcosensor II:
- “(b) Dräger 7110:
- “(c) Intoxilyzer 5000:
- “(d) Seres.”

**4. Approval of conclusive evidential breath-testing devices**—Clause 8 of the principal notice is hereby amended by omitting the expression “paragraphs (b) to (e)”, and substituting the expression “paragraphs (b) to (d)”.

**5. Manner of carrying out evidential breath tests by means of Dräger 7110, Intoxilyzer 5000, or Seres**—Clause 10 of the principal notice is hereby amended by omitting the expression “a DataMaster,”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This notice, which comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*, amends the Transport (Breath Tests) Notice (No. 2) 1989. The notice removes references in the principal notice to the DataMaster device and updates the definition of the Seres device. It also reapproves the Alconsensor II, Dräger 7110, Intoxilyzer 5000, and Seres devices.
