THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, and Section 14 of the Maori Land Amendment and Maori Land Claims Adjustment Act, 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Taupo Trout-fishing Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 4.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and deemed part of the Taupo Trout-fishing Regulations 1939* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the day on which they are made.

4. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the principal regulations or in any amendment thereof, the open season which commenced on the 1st day of November, 1947, shall extend to and include the 31st day of May, 1948.

5. All whole-season licences to fish for trout in the district on or after the 1st day of November, 1947, shall be deemed to have been issued for a period expiring on the 31st day of May, 1948.
