ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Transport (Vehicular Traffic Road Closure) Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Transport (Vehicular Traffic Road Closure) Regulations 1965* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations). (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the

date of their notification in the Gazette.

2. Meaning of "road"—Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the following definition:

"'Road' does not include any foreshore (as defined in section 2 (1) of the Harbours Act 1950)."

3. Amendments to Second Schedule to principal regulations-The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended-

(a) By omitting from the part of the third column that relates to section 52 of the Transport Act 1962 the words "30 miles", and substituting the words "50 kilometres":

(b) By omitting from the part of the third column that relates to regulation 8 of the Traffic Regulations 1956 the words "bends, intersections, or rises where middle lines marked", and substituting the words "places where 'no-overtaking' lines marked".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

Regulation 2 excludes foreshores from the operation of the principal regulations. The holding of motor vehicle races or trials on the foreshore are governed by the Regulations as to Foreshores made under the Harbours Act 1923 (Gazette, 8 January 1932, p. 31).

Regulation 3 makes amendments to the Second Schedule to the principal regulations that are consequential on amendments made to enactments specified in that Schedule.
