ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 77 and 199 of the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Transport (Vehicular Traffic Road Closure) Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Transport (Vehicular Traffic Road Closure) Regulations 1965* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of November 1989.

2. Offences—Regulation 11 (3) of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Transport (Vehicular Traffic Road Closure) Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 1) is hereby amended by

omitting the expression “subsection (4)”, and substituting the expression “subsection (1)”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations correct a cross-reference to the appropriate penalty provision in section 30 of the Transport Act 1962.

From 1 November 1989 offences against the Transport (Vehicular Traffic Road Closure) Regulations 1965 may be proceeded with as infringement offences pursuant to Part IX of the new Second Schedule to the Transport Act 1962, as enacted by the Transport Amendment Act 1989.
