NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Transport (Approved Vehicle Surveillance Equipment) Amendment Notice 1999, and is part of the Transport (Approved Vehicle Surveillance Equipment) Notice 1994* (“the principal notice”).

(2) This notice comes into force on 1 March 1999.

2. Approval of AutoPatrol PR-100NZ—Clause 2 of the principal notice is amended by omitting the expression “Transport Act 1962”, and substituting the expression “Land Transport Act 1998”.

3. Approval of AutoPatrol SP-200—Clause 3 of the principal notice is amended by omitting the expression “Transport Act 1962”, and substituting the expression “Land Transport Act 1998”.
