THE UNIVERSITY BURSARIES REGULATIONS 1971, AMENDMENT NO. 2

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the University Bursaries Regulations 1971, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the University Bursaries Regulations 1971* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Supplementary allowances—(1) Regulation 33 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting after paragraph (c) of

subclause (2) the following paragraph:

"(d) Has been awarded a fees and allowances bursary under paragraph (e) of subclause (1) of regulation 14 of these regulations, and being enrolled at a university in New Zealand in any year after the year 1972 has been granted, in recognition of the merit of his results in successfully completing a course prescribed under the Technicians Certification Act 1958 for which he has been awarded a New Zealand Certificate, credits towards or exemptions from not less than 1 year's work of his recognised course."

(2) The said regulation 33 is hereby further amended, consequentially, by omitting from paragraph (c) of subclause (2) the word "subclause.",

and substituting the words "subclause; or".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the University Bursaries Regulations 1971. The effect is to enable payment of a supplementary allowance of \$100 a year to holders of New Zealand Certificates who in recognition of the merit of their results in the course for that certificate have been granted credits towards or exemptions from not less than 1 year's work of the recognised course for which they have been awarded a fees and allowances bursary under regulation 14 (1) (e) of the principal regulations.
