PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the United World Colleges Scholarships Regulations 1980, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the United World Colleges Scholarships Regulations 1980\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of September 1985.

**2. United World Colleges Scholarships established**—(1) Regulation 3 (4) of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

(a) By omitting from paragraph (a) the expression “£400” (as substituted by regulation 3 of the United World Colleges Scholarships Regulations 1980, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the expression “£420”:

- (b) By omitting from paragraph (b) the expression “£180” (as so substituted), and substituting the expression “£190”:
- (c) By omitting from paragraph (c) the expression “£180” (as so substituted), and substituting the expression “£190”.
- (2) Regulation 3 of the United World Colleges Scholarships Regulations 1980, Amendment No. 1 is hereby consequentially revoked.
