



**THE VETERINARY SURGEONS REGULATIONS 1958,  
AMENDMENT NO. 8**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 23rd day of March 1992

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Veterinary Surgeons Act 1956, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Veterinary Surgeons Regulations 1958, Amendment No. 8, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Veterinary Surgeons Regulations 1958\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Fees**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 5 (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Veterinary Surgeons Regulations 1958, Amendment No. 7), and substituting the following regulation:

“5. (1) The fee payable on every application for registration as a veterinary surgeon shall be \$157.50.

“(2) The fee payable for a certificate under section 32A of the Act shall be \$112.50.”

**3. Consequential amendment**—The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby consequentially amended by omitting from Form 1 the sentence beginning with the words “Application fee of”, and substituting the following sentence:

“Application fee of \$157.50 is enclosed.”

**4. Goods and services tax included**—The fees prescribed by these regulations are inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.

**5. Revocation**—The Veterinary Surgeons Regulations 1958, Amendment No. 7 is hereby consequentially revoked.

**6. Saving in respect of fee for annual practising certificate**—Notwithstanding the provisions of regulation 5 (2) of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 of these regulations) and the provisions of regulations 2 and 5 of these regulations, the fee payable for any certificate issued under section 32A of the Act in respect of the year ending with the 31st day of March 1992 shall be \$60.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations increase fees prescribed by the Veterinary Surgeons Regulations 1958.

The fee payable on an application for registration as a veterinary surgeon is increased from \$128 to \$157.50 but the fee of \$5.70 previously payable for a certificate of registration is abolished.

The fee payable by a veterinary surgeon for an annual practising certificate is increased from \$60 to \$112.50 although the fee payable for a practising certificate issued in respect of the year ending with 31 March 1992 remains at \$60.

The fees prescribed are inclusive of goods and services tax.
