ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 1st day of March 1965

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. KEITH HOLYOAKE, C.H., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Summary Proceedings Act 1957 and to the Public Revenues Act 1953 (so far as these regulations relate to witnesses and interpreters paid by the Crown under regulation 4 of the Witnesses and Interpreters Fees Regulations 1959), His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Witnesses and Interpreters Fees Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Witnesses and Interpreters Fees Regulations 1959* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the seventh day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraphs (a) to (c) of clause 6, and substituting the following paragraph:

“(a) The cost of travelling by such mode and class of public transport as the Court or paying officer considers reasonable having regard to the distance travelled, the age and health of the witness or interpreter, and any other relevant circumstances:

“Provided that air fares shall not be allowed unless the Court or paying officer is satisfied that any extra expense occasioned by the use of air transport is justified in all the circumstances:”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Witnesses and Interpreters Fees Regulations 1959 so that Courts and paying officers will have a greater discretion in allowing travelling expenses. Individual circumstances may be taken into account and air fares allowed in appropriate cases.
