**THE WEIGHTS AND MEASURES METRIC PACKAGES NOTICE
1975**

PURSUANT to subsection (3A) of section 39 of the Weights and Measures Act 1925, the Minister of Labour hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Weights and Measures Metric Packages Notice 1975.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Metric packages of bar soap, soft soap, black japan, and brunswick black—Notwithstanding any regulations for the time being in force and made under section 39 (1) (r) of the Weights and Measures Act 1925, any article specified in the Schedule to this notice may be sold by retail so long as it is enclosed in a package of one of the net weights or measures specified in that Schedule in relation to that article.

Soft soap ..		500 g or multiples of 500 g
Black japan ..	{	25 ml, 50 ml
Brunswick black ..		75 ml, 100 ml, 250 ml, 500 ml, or multiples of 500 ml
		25 g, 50 g, 75 g, 100 g, 250 g, 500 g, or multiples of 500 g

This notice enables certain articles to be sold by retail in packages of the net weights and measures specified in it in relation to the respective articles. It does not restrict the right to use the Imperial weights and measures already prescribed in relation to those articles.
